The Rack Tiers

For setup, use the metal shelves and numbered slots to create the 4 "Tiers." We've named them to make it easy to remember each tier's purpose: Shade, Gravy, Meat + Potatoes, and Dessert.

Make sure the top bar is at the back. Set the shelves at 6, 16, and 26. Put the extra shelves at the top to create filtered shade. These shelves do not move.



Joining the Racks

Once the racks are created, you can build a semi-permanent shelf system of endcaps and shelves. Join racks side-by-side and back-to-back in various numbers to fit space available.

This configuration shows 2 endcaps + 8 racks + 2 endcaps , creating a 12-rack shelf system.



Zip It In Place!

Place a 16" zip tie at the top and bottom of sides where racks join. Your semi-permanent shelf system is now complete!

Rack Placement

The vertical merchandising location will be pre-determined by the Merchandising Manager and Market Director before spring season begins.

Restock + Refresh

Once the racks are in place, constantly pull plants from top (Gravy) and bottom (Dessert) to keep the high-sales tier (Meat + Potatoes) full and fresh. When new racks roll in from the plant farm, pull distressed product from tables and racks. Condense product at Meat + Potatoes tier, and restock Dessert and Gravy.

Constantly pulling from these areas to re-rack the middle keeps plants from drying out and improves aeration.

By expanding vertically, we can get more product customer-facing per square foot. We increase our inventory — and our sales.
